BUS_ Return ticket approx. €33pp

Bus Eireann operates a bus from Dublin Airport to Letterkenny. You should book your tickets online and leave 1.5 hours gap between your arrival time and the bus departure time.


CAR Hiring a car for 7 days from about €170

You can hire a car and drive to
Letterkenny. There are several
reliable car hire companies
present at Dublin Airport. Please
note that we drive on the left side
of the road and the driver sits on
the right side of the car!

PLANE Return ticket approx. €120pp

Amapola operates flights twice daily from Dublin Airport into the World's Most Scenic Airport!

Please note that you will need to take a taxi or a bus to Letterkenny as this airport is about 60km far from Letterkenny.

IS ABOUT 5 MINUTES.


BUS INFORMATION FOR EU, EEA AND SWISS CITIZENS

When booking your bus ticket online, you can choose Terminal 2, if your plane arrives to Terminal 2 **OR** choose one of the Zones from the drop down menu if your plane arrives to Terminal 1. There are a lot of guides (wearing bright yellow jackets), and I highly advise you to ask them which zone your bus is departing from as this can change without the post signs being updated.

You can also purchase your ticket on the bus by paying in cash (Euro only), however, the ticket prices online are usually cheaper.

Please note, that Route 32 bus DOES cross the UK border. If you are an EU, EEA and Swiss citizen, you can transit through/travel to the UK if you hold a valid passport. Please note that there is no hard border, so there will be no passport control. The journey takes approximately 3.5 hours.

BUS INFORMATION FOR NON-EU, EEA AND SWISS CITIZENS

When booking your bus ticket online, you can choose Terminal 2, if your plane arrives to Terminal 2 OR choose one of the Zones from the drop down menu if your plane arrives to Terminal 1. There are a lot of guides (wearing bright yellow jackets), and I highly advise you to ask them which zone your bus is departing from as this can change without the post signs being updated.

You can also purchase your ticket on the bus by paying in cash (Euro only), however, the ticket prices online are usually cheaper.

Please note, that you will need to take 2 buses: Route 23, from Dublin Airport to Sligo, then Route 64 bus from Sligo to Letterkenny. These buses DON'T cross the UK border. However, you will need to make sure to get off the bus in Letterkenny as Route 64's final destination is Derry, UK. The journey takes approximately 5 hours.

RENTING A CAR

Hiring a car from Dublin Airport (DUB) is simple. Hertz, Europcar, Avis, Enterprise, Budget and local operator Dooley have a presence in Terminal 1's arrivals hall and Terminal 2's multi-storey car park.

The road signage is excellent and you can easily navigate without a GPS. However, most cars have a built in GPS or you can use your phone's GPS. If you are an EU, EEA OR SWISS CITIZEN, you can follow the fastest route below:

M1 --> N2 --> A5 --> N14 (Dublin Airport via Dundalk, Monaghan, Omagh (UK) and Strabane (UK)).

Approximate journey time: 3 hours.

If you are a NON-EU, EEA OR SWISS
CITIZEN, you can follow the fastest route
below:

M4 --> N4 --> N15 --> N13 (Dublin Airport via Mullingar, Sligo, Donegal town)

Approximate journey time: 4.5 hours.

FLYING FROM DUBLIN AIRPORT TO DONEGAL

Amapola operates flights twice daily from Dublin into the World's Most Scenic Airport, Donegal CFN!

Located at Carrickfinn, Kincasslagh, the airport is approximately 45 mins drive from Letterkenny. Donegal Airport is just 45 minutes flying time from Dublin and is a region noted for its unspoiled natural scenery, its maritime environment and fishing industry, inhabited islands and a unique tourism industry.

If you are flying from Dublin to Donegal, please make sure that you leave a minimum of 2 hours between the arrival and departure time of your connected flights.

- International

TRAVEL GUIDE

AIRPORTER Return ticket approx. €40pp

Regardless of which airport you arrive in Belfast, Airporter picks you up right at the front of the airport entrance. You must book your tickets online in advance. Airporter will take you to Derry bus station, and from there, you can take Bus 64 to Letterkenny. Click on the link above to view timetables and click here to book your ticket.

CAR Hiring a car for 7 days from about €170

You can hire a car and drive to Letterkenny. There are several reliable car hire companies present at Belfast Airports. You can Google the the companies or use <u>Travelsupermarket</u> to compare.



YOUR JOURNEY

There are 2 ways to get from Derry Airport to Letterkenny: by bus or car Derry has 1 Airport:

City of Derry

You can fly into Derry from several airports from UK.

TRAVEL GUIDE

BUS Return ticket approx. €17pp

You will need to take a taxi from City of Derry Airport to Foyle Street Bus station, which can cost approx. £5. From this bus station you can take Bus 64 to Letterkenny. You can buy the bus ticket on the bus.

CAR Hiring a car for 7 days from about €80

You can hire a car and drive to Letterkenny. You can Google the car hire companies present at City of Derry Airport.
